A Kairos moment a change in season:

I feel we are living in a significant time in the life of our church at the moment. The bible refers to time in 2 ways:

- Chronological time: Hour by hour, day by day, year by year.
- Kairos time: A time of opportunity or appointed time.

How we transition from one season/circumstance to another is crucial as often the lessons of one season prepare us for success in the next.

Transitioning from one season to another successfully:

Joshua: 4:19-5:1

On the tenth day of the first month the people went up from the Jordan and camped at Gilgal on the eastern border of Jericho. <sup>20</sup> And Joshua set up at Gilgal the twelve stones they had taken out of the Jordan. <sup>21</sup> He said to the Israelites, "In the future when your descendants ask their parents, 'What do these stones mean?' <sup>22</sup> tell them, 'Israel crossed the Jordan on dry ground.' <sup>23</sup> For the LORD your God dried up the Jordan before you until you had crossed over. The LORD your God did to the Jordan what he had done to the Red Sea<sup>[b]</sup> when he dried it up before us until we had crossed over. <sup>24</sup> He did this so that all the peoples of the earth might know that the hand of the LORD is powerful and so that you might always fear the LORD your God."

**5** Now when all the Amorite kings west of the Jordan and all the Canaanite kings along the coast heard how the LORD had dried up the Jordan before the Israelites until they<sup>[a]</sup> had crossed over, their hearts melted in fear and they no longer had the courage to face the Israelites.

Transitioning from one season to another successfully:

#### Why 12 stones?

- 1. To celebrate the wonder and signs they witnessed and heard of the 10 plagues, the supernatural provision in the wilderness, the cloud by day, the pillar of fire by night, the crossing of the Red Sea and now the crossing of the river Jordon
- 2. To teach and instruct their children what God is like.
- 3. To tell their enemies what God is like, so they melt with fear.
- 4. To remind themselves that God, is mighty and powerful!

Transitioning from one season to another successfully:

- The Promised Land wasn't given to Israel on a plate.
- We need to remind ourselves what has happened, 'The
  Journey so Far', so we can be empowered and full of faith for
  'The Journey Ahead'.

# The Journey Ahead: Passionate




#### Brave:

#### The Journey Ahead: Brave








#### Real:






#### Family:
